We say Goodbye to Richard on Monday but he will return in August when the school is back from their holidays.

Ordination of Rene De Los Reyes: Deacon Rene will be ordained into the Priesthood on 28th August in Aberdeen. This will be held in the evening so it is hoped that we may be able to do a group booking on the train for that event. Please let us know if you are interested in going.

Parish Music and Dancing Social – Friday 7th August at 7.30pm on the Feast of St Mary MacKillop. We hope to be joined by parishioners from Nairn and Stratherrick. Entertainment will include John the ‘Prof’, Joe Campbell and others. Tickets are £10, payable on the door, in aid of Our Lady’s shrine at Stratherrick. Bring and share food and drink. Prizes for the raffle and volunteers to help set up, man the door and wash up will be greatly appreciated. Sacred Heart Banner: We have found a beautiful banner of the Sacred Heart, but it is in desperate need of some restoration. Is there anyone who has embroidery skills who would like to take on this small project? Please speak to Fr Laurence if you can help.

Adjustments are underway to certain benches within the Church to make it compliant with current regulations. This will allow better access for wheelchairs and mobility aids in the main part of the Church.

During the summer months, when we have adequate Eucharistic cover, Communion under both kinds will be offered during the weekday Masses.

Holy hour and Benediction will be re-introduced on Sundays at 5.15pm for the months of July and August, commencing this Sunday, 5th July.

Hymn Singing: We would like to integrate our various communities more fully within the Church especially the Sunday Mass at 11am. The initial thought is that one of the Communion hymns could be sung in their various languages. Father will speak to those who might be involved.

Also, we plan to **move the choir** to the front of the church next week at the 11am Mass, so please leave the first two benches free in the extension.

Organ training: It is planned to hold a meeting in August for those who have expressed an interest in undertaking training on the organ. Those interested should already be reasonably proficient in the piano. Training will commence in September.

Meals Service: Volunteers and/or contributions will still be most welcome.

The SCIAF Shield: Returns on Saturday 1st August - The SCIAF Shield is a 5-a-side tournament that brings together 16 teams for an exciting afternoon of community and sport – all in support of SCIAF's life-changing work overseas. Listed Places of Worship Update: The UK-wide Listed Places of Worship Grant Scheme has closed, and the replacement fund applies only in England. For many parishes and dioceses in Scotland, this means essential repairs and improvement projects for listed church buildings will become more expensive, placing further pressure on already stretched budgets. You are encouraged to write to your MSPs to ask for clarity on support in Scotland and to back a practical Scottish funding route.
